About Us:

We are very proud of the fire protection, emergency medical, and rescue services that we provide to our community and its visitors. Snohomish County Fire District #5 proudly serves approximately



10,000 people living in the Sultan & Startup areas. We protect 72 square miles of primarily rural area in Snohomish County.

The department employs a Fire Chief, one full time Deputy Fire Chief, one volunteer Deputy Chief, six full time firefighters, and 26 volunteers who respond to approximately 1000 alarms per year.

Our full time firefighters staff our station seven days a week 6a-6p. Evenings are covered by volunteers who either work shifts at the station or respond from home.

We are governed by three fire commissioners who are elected to six year terms.

Many of our volunteers are seeking careers in the fire service and join Fire District #5 to gain valuable training and experience. There is far more to earning a career in the fire service than learning technical skills. Learning how to work as a team, communicate with peers and public, act with initiative, and put forth hard work are the skills employers most want.
